

# Sustainable Agriculture in Tunisia

The over-exploitation of water resources, land degradation and climate change risks are exacerbating the problems faced by the agricultural sector in Tunisia. Training and extension programs provided by state agricultural advisory services are limited, and not sufficiently adapted to farmers' needs. In this context, GIZ implements the programme "Promotion of sustainable agriculture and rural development in Tunisia" (PAD II) to strengthen climate change adaptation capacities in the Northwest and Central West regions of Tunisia. UNIQUE was contracted to support the application and training of good agricultural practices for improving the productivity, management, and market integration of climate-resilient agricultural products.
